

State Mandated Organic Recycling Is Now Here!

USE THESE HELPFUL TIPS

- Bag all food scraps.
- Freeze your food waste until collection date.
- Clean out fridge the night before pick up day.
- Drain all liquids, less heavy and less messy.

We require that the food waste be bagged for three reasons:

- 1. The disposal facility requires bags to separate the food waste from the yard waste, which they will process differently.
- 2. Bags will help keep your containers clean
- 3. Using clear or transparent bags prevents us from having to open the bags when we do our waste audits.

GREAT: Compostable transparent bags (i.e. BioBags, greenish clearish bags available at most grocery or food store)

VERY GOOD: Clear plastic bags like the ones used for produce at the grocery store, liners from cereal boxes, zip lock bags, bags that you already have!

GOOD: Newly purchased clear plastic liners OR paper bags, reused or newly purchased

NOT GOOD: Newly purchased black or otherwise opaque plastic bags

NO! Pet Waste, Raw Meat, Fats or Oils. These items do not belong in the organics cart. They are not compostable at our facility. Place unacceptable items such as these in the trash.

BIOGRAPHIES



Jerry R. Soria-Foust Artistic Director & Conductor

Jerry is a professional music educator and arts leader, with a career spanning more than 25 years. At the age of 19, Jerry had his first GALA choruses experience, performing in the inaugural season of the Indianapolis Men's Chorus. That experience was transformational, and he credits participation in a number of GALA organizations for the fulfilling life he leads as a teacher, leader, artist, husband, dad and grandpa.

From 2005-2009, Jerry served as Artistic Director for the San Diego Men's Chorus, where he led the chorus through a number of milestones, including performing as main stage entertainment on an ocean liner for RSVP cruises, singing the national anthem for the San Diego Padres, and becoming the resident choral ensemble in the newly renovated Balboa Theatre in downtown San Diego. During his time with SDMC, the Chorus collaborated

with a number of award-winning artists, including Tony-nominated Sharon McNight, Broadway & American Idol star Frenchie Davis, Olympic legend Greg Louganis, playwright Del Shores, Grammy-nominated Westwind Brass, the San Diego Women's Drum Circle, and more.

Jerry was the Founding Director of Opus Q – A Men's Vocal Ensemble, a select ensemble specializing in diverse repertoire performed in intimate settings in the Bay Area. He also served briefly as the Artistic Director for the Lesbian/Gay Chorus of San Francisco, where the chorus collaborated with luminaries like Sharon Gless and Sir lan McKellen, as well as the San Francisco Gay Men's Chorus.

As a professional theatre director and producer, Jerry has been involved in over 100-ticketed productions. As Executive Director and Director of Education of Berkeley Playhouse, he led expansion of the organizations programs, ticket sales, subscribers and budget by 400%. From 2011-2019, Jerry founded and served as Artistic Director of Windy City Performs, an all-ages professional theatre and conservatory in Chicago, where he created after-school and pre-professional training programs in music, dance and theatre. WCP was nominated for multiple Broadway World Chicago awards over the years; and was named Chicago Magazine's Readers' Choice award for Best Theatre in 2016.

Jerry's passions include inspiring people of all ages to love the performing arts, creating access to life-changing performing arts opportunities for children of all backgrounds, and exploring how the arts can answer some of today's most difficult challenges. Jerry is a graduate of Butler University and San Diego State University. In addition to serving as the proud director of PSGMC, Jerry currently teaches instrumental and choral music in Riverside County.

Joel serves on the faculty of Midsummer Musical Retreat in Walla Walla, WA, and on the accompanist staff for Musical Theater University in Rancho Mirage. He also plays for various cabaret artists in the area, and has won two Desert Theatre League awards for his work. 



Michael Nickerson-Rossi

Michael Nickerson-Rossi's choreography and educational impact is vastly valuable and is nationally and internationally renowned. "He's the real thing," said Janice Stienberg from Dance Magazine.

Michael launched and founded his dance company, "Nickerson-Rossi Dance," in 2011. His firm belief in charitable and educational benefits propelled Michael to incorporate his company into a non-profit 501c3. The non-profit mission of Nickerson-Rossi Dance is to provide dance programs to youth, young adults and adults that focus on dance education, dance as a

therapeutic value, and access to professional performances.

Local philanthropist Terri Ketover believed in Michael's work and commissioned the company to perform at the Palm Springs Art Museum's Annenberg Theater in 2012. He was motivated to create and provide educational experiences to the Coachella Valley and began to work with the Palm Springs Unified School District under the Helene Galen Foundation for the following 3 years.

His reputable work brought Michael to the East Coast where the position of Creative Director of Dance was created for him at the Uptown! Knauer Performing Arts Center in Pennsylvania created the position for Michael as their Creative Director of Dance because of his renowned work.

While on the east coast in 2018, he built a modern/contemporary technique program and performance series at Princeton Ballet in Princeton, New Jersey. Additionally, he is a current and founding faculty member at Johns Hopkins University's Peabody Conservatory, in Baltimore, Maryland, where he teaches modern technique, composition and dance production. Other notable higher educational institutions Michael has educated include: New York University, Loyola Marymount University, American College Dance Festival, Drexel University, Rock School (west) and over 30 other universities.

While traveling between the east and west coasts, Michael was commissioned a second time by the Palm Springs Art Museum where he produced his concert "Past & Present" in 2016. As an outgrowth of this program, he founded and produced the Palm Springs Dance Festival (2015/2019). His organization continued gaining momentum which led into an expansion and reformation, the Festival is now, Palm Springs International Dance Festival.

The "uNdeRstanD program," was created to carry out Michael's mission for his outreach work. This provides all diverse and minority communities a platform to engage in artistic expression, and unify the body and creativity as a tool when words are not enough. His passion to impact has been felt by organizations such as: LGBTQ Center in Long Beach, Versa-Style P.E.C. in Los Angeles, Project Home in Philadelphia, Barbara Sinatra Children's Center, Desert Regional Hospital (Comprehensive Cancer Center) and Palm Springs Unified School District. Nickerson-Rossi Dance partnered with Riverside County's Office of Education in 2020 and reached 7 High Schools and 1 Middle School.

The growth of the International Dance Festival inspired Michael to move to Palm Springs full time and establish the Palm Springs Dance Academy. The Academy is the official school of the Nickerson-Rossi Dance Company, where they provide comprehensive dance education for pre-professional dancers and to serve the community with enrichment, outreach, homeschool and after school dance programs. Nickerson-Rossi's Dance House is Michael's current expanding vision. He is excited to share cultural and diversified dance programming into the Coachella Valley. This dance theater has allowed us to curate sustainable dance and art programming. Michael's current endeavor and vision is Nickerson-Rossi's Dance House, his home venue to curate dance and art programming in Palm Springs, California.
