Besides Hamilton, she is best known for her emotional portrayal of Nina Rosario in the Tony® Award winning, Lin-Manuel Miranda Broadway musical "In The Heights," a role she originally created Off Broadway receiving a Drama Desk Award for Best Ensemble. She starred as Elphaba on Broadway in "Wicked," blowing the roof off of the Gershwin Theatre each night, for which she received a Broadway.com Award for Best Replacement.
