

GUEST ARTIST



KRISTINE W

Named by Billboard Magazine as the #8 Greatest Dance Artist of All Time and the #3 greatest from the Last Decade, Kristine W has proven herself a lasting talent. Through nearly twenty-five years in music, she has consistency delivered songs that touch hearts and souls and compel bodies to find the mighty groove out on the dance floor. She's had 17 #1 singles in her career, tying Mariah Carey for the sixth-most Billboard #1 dance hits.

Kristine W's first #1 was in 1996 with her debut single, "Feel What You Want." She quickly

followed it with her second chart-topper, "One More Try." And then a third: "Land of the Living," securing Kristine's place as a new dance floor star. When the Land of the Living album was officially released in 1997, Kristine's in-store concert at the Virgin Megastore in Times Square drew lines of adoring fans around the block.

She signed with RCA Records for her 2000 album, Stronger, landing at #1 with its title tune and "Lovin' You." Then tragedy struck. Kristine was diagnosed with a particularly aggressive strain of leukemia that had only a 30 percent chance of survival. She was given an experimental stem cell transplant and spent the next two years fighting the disease while also raising two infant children.

In 2003, Kristine returned to music with a new album Fly Again, this time with the pioneering indie dance label, Tommy Boy. She racked up three more #1s: the title song, "Save My Soul" and "The Wonder of It All."

After topping the charts again with her dance remake of the Ashford/Simpson-penned Diana Ross hit "The Boss," Kristine debuted as a totally independent and self-managed artist with 2009's The Power of Music album. Its seven #1 hits proved Kristine's enduring appeal as a major dance music artist. In 2015, Kristine released her New & Number Ones album where she revisited some of her past hits with new mixes and edits and offered new songs that also topped the charts.

In 2018, she released "Stars", her 17th Billboard #1. The song was included on Billboard's "Best 100 Dance Songs of 2018," coming in at #25, next to Ariana Grande and U2. Her last album release was 2020's Love and Lies. Kristine's next album is scheduled to release in summer 2024.

BIOGRAPHIES



Jerry R. Soria-Foust Artistic Director & Conductor

Jerry R. Soria-Foust is a professional music educator and arts leader, with a career spanning more than 30 years. At the age of 19, Jerry had his first GALA Choruses experience, performing in the inaugural season of the Indianapolis Men's Chorus. That experience was transformational, and he credits participation in a number of GALA organizations for the fulfilling life he leads as a an artist, husband and dad.

From 2005-2009, Jerry served as Artistic Director for the San Diego Men's Chorus, where he led the chorus through a number of milestones, including performing as main stage entertainment on an ocean liner for RSVP Cruises, singing the national anthem for the San Diego Padres, and becoming the resident choral ensemble in the newly renovated Balboa Theatre in downtown

San Diego. During his time with SDMC, the Chorus collaborated with a number of award-winning artists, including Tony-nominated Sharon McNight, Broadway & American Idol star Frenchie Davis, Olympic legend Greg Louganis, playwright Del Shores, Grammy-nominated Westwind Brass, the San Diego Women's Drum Circle, and more.

Jerry was the Founding Director of Opus Q – A Men's Vocal Ensemble, a select group specializing in diverse repertoire performed in intimate settings in the Bay Area. He also served as Artistic Director for the Lesbian/Gay Chorus of San Francisco, during which time the ensemble collaborated with luminaries like Sharon Gless and Sir Ian McKellen, and he had the honor of guest conducting the San Francisco Gay Men's Chorus in performance on two occasions.

As a professional theatre director and producer, Jerry has been involved in over 100-ticketed productions. As Executive Director and Director of Education of Berkeley Playhouse, he led expansion of the organization' programs, ticket sales, subscribers and budget by 400%. From 2011-2019, Jerry served as Artistic Director and Dean of Windy City Performs, an all-ages professional theatre and conservatory in Chicago, where he created after-school and pre-professional training programs in music, dance and theatre. WCP was nominated for multiple Broadway World Chicago awards over the years; and was named Chicago Magazine's Readers' Choice award for Best Theatre in 2016.

Jerry's passions include inspiring people of all ages to find their voice in the performing arts. The main thrust of his work has been to create life-changing access to music, dance and theatre opportunities for young people of all backgrounds; and to explore the ways the performing arts can answer some of today's most difficult challenges. Jerry is a graduate of Butler University and San Diego State University, and has just finished his school building administrator license.

Joel is a native of the Seattle area and a graduate of the University of Washington School of Music. He moved to the Desert in 2003 and has busy as a pianist and music director ever since. Currently, he can be found playing for *The Judy Show*, starring Michael Holmes, and for the musical revue *Palm Springs Jump!*, at the Purple Room.

Joel serves on the faculty of Midsummer Musical Retreat in Walla Walla, WA, and on the accompanist staff for Musical Theater University in Rancho Mirage. He also plays for various cabaret artists in the area, and has won two Desert Theatre League awards for his work. Among local theaters where Joel has taken on the title of Music Director are: Palm Canyon Theatre, Desert

Theatreworks, Desert Rose, and Desert Ensemble Theatre Company. Joel and his husband, Don Vasconcelos, are the authors of the song "Christmas In Palm Springs".

He served as Associate Conductor on the National Tour of Newsies and can be heard playing piano in the Broadway HD movie. New York and National Tour keyboard and/or conducting credits include Les Misérables, Sunset Boulevard, Miss Saigon, Mary Poppins, Ragtime, The Fantasticks, and A Gentleman's Guide to Love and Murder. He has also music-directed several full-scale and "Broadway Junior" musicals at his schools. Jeff is an active member of the Palm Springs Teachers Association and serves as one of their CTA State Council reps. A graduate of Chapman University's Conservatory of Music (B.M. Music Education; Conducting), he is currently studying for a Masters degree at CSU San Bernardino.



Doug Nagel Resident Vocal Coach

Montana native Doug Nagel sang over 80 operatic baritone roles including Count, Scarpia, Dracula, Dutchman, Figaro, and Germont. Doug returns to Billings in March to sing John the Baptist and direct Rimrock Opera's production of Salome. Doug premiered the role of Theseus in Roumanis' Phaedra, broadcast on PBS. International attention came when he created the role of de Santander in the Virginia Opera world premiere of Musgrave's Simon Bolìvar, later singing the production at the Royal Albert Hall, London, broadcast on the BBC. Mr. Nagel is heard on Albany Records in Nosferatu as the title role of Orlock (Dracula).

Nagel was the Artistic Director of Rimrock Opera, where he guided 26 productions including Aïda, Così, Traviata, Butterfly, Crucible, Barber, Merry Widow, Bohème, Figaro, Girl of the Golden West, Elixir, Tosca, Carmen. Doug has judged the Metropolitan Opera National Council Auditions and sat on the NEA Opera Grant Committee.

Nagel recently retired as Associate Professor from MSU Billings. Residing in the Coachella Valley with his husband, Steve Baker, a longtime member of PSGMC and former board president. Nagel has a voice studio and directs the troupe of professional singers, Coachella Valley Classical Voices. Doug proudly serves as the Vocal Coach for PSGMC.

It is my pleasure to stand before this amazing group of singers--all of whom dedicate their time and talent every week to bring you an inspiring concert each holiday and Spring, as well as support and participate in many of the causes that make the Coachella Valley such a vibrant place to live!

The music you will hear tonight is a collection of soaring songs that celebrate the human spirit. My friend, Kristine W, is the perfect complement to this program, as her entire career has been dedicated to uplifting our community and inspiring others to soar beyond the limitations of gravity. She is not only a Billboard #1 artist (one of the all-time greatest!), but she is an ally to our community like no one else! I know many of you have enjoyed dancing to her music over the past 25 years!

This program is notable not just because of the beauty of the pieces, but because many of selections on the program are being performed for the first time; they have been commissioned by

PSGMC for this concert or borrowed as unpublished works from composers or other choruses especially for this program.

We feel a sense of pride and responsibility to represent our wonderful Palm Springs community in front of wildly enthusiastic audiences in world-class venues. Many of the pieces you hear tonight will be on our festival program.

In our last piece, Joseph Martin's The Awakening, the chorus sings of a dream where music has disappeared--where no steeples ring, no birds sing and no choirs sing to change the world. It is a hopeless and stark world, a world of literal silence. As the dream ends, we awaken to hear bells ringing and voices singing out. The world is alive again with the sound of music. It is a call for us all to let music live in our own lives and in the world around us.
