We coordinate, with your help, a Toy Drive for Martha's Village and Kitchen, a School Supplies Drive for Elementary Schools in the Coachella Valley, and as you will hear from one of our recipient schools tonight, we supply a grant to twelve school's GSA student groups to encourage acceptance and safety to our students in our valley.

Thanks to support from grants from the cities of Palm Spring and Rancho Mirage we are invited to sing for various community events including Palm Springs Pride, the DAP Equity Walk, Rancho Mirage Library Series, and other community events.

We are singers from various walks of life: teachers, doctors, students, designers, and bean counters. Our music brings us together each week to sing, to blend, to memorize. We do what we love and we hope that you find joy in our sound. Thank you for your support





BIOGRAPHIES



Jerry R. Soria-Foust Artistic Director & Conductor

Jerry R. Soria-Foust is a professional music educator and arts leader, with a career spanning more than 25 years. At the age of 19, Jerry had his first GALA choruses experience, performing in the inaugural season of the Indianapolis Men's Chorus. That experience was transformational, and he credits participation in a number of GALA organizations for the fulfilling life he leads as a conductor and activist today.

From 2004-2009, Jerry served as Artistic Director for the San Diego Men's Chorus, where he led the chorus through a number of milestones, including performing as mainstage entertainment on an ocean liner for RSVP Cruises, singing the national anthem for the San Diego Padres, and becoming the resident choral ensemble in the newly renovated Balboa Theatre in downtown

San Diego. During his time with SDMC, the Chorus collaborated with a number of award-winning artists, including Tony-nominated Sharon McNight, Broadway & American Idol star Frenchie Davis, Olympic legend Greg Louganis, playwright Del Shores, Grammy-nominated Westwind Brass, the San Diego Women's Drum Circle, and more.

Jerry was the Founding Director of Opus Q – A Men's Vocal Ensemble, a select ensemble specializing in diverse repertoire performed in intimate settings in the Bay Area. He also served briefly as the Artistic Director for the Lesbian/Gay Chorus of San Francisco, where the chorus collaborated with luminaries like Sharon Gless and Sir Ian McKellen, as well as guest-conducted the San Francisco Gay Men's Chorus on several occasions.

As a professional theatre director and producer, Jerry has been involved in over 100-ticketed productions. As Executive Director and Director of Education of Berkeley Playhouse, he led a drastic expansion of the organization's programs, ticket sales, subscribers and budget. From 2011-2019, Jerry founded and served as Artistic Director of Windy City Performs, an all-ages professional theatre and conservatory in Chicago, where he created after-school and pre-professional training programs in music, dance and theatre. WCP was nominated for multiple BroadwayWorld Chicago awards over the years; and was named Chicago Magazine's Readers' Choice award for Best Theatre in 2016.

Jerry's passions include inspiring people of all ages to love the performing arts, creating access to lifechanging performing arts opportunities for children of all backgrounds, and exploring how the arts can answer some of today's most difficult challenges. Jerry is a graduate of Butler University, the American College of Education and San Diego State University.

Jerry serves on the Education & Membership Committee of GALA Choruses and is a member of the American Choral Directors' Association.



Joel Baker Principal Accompanist

Joel Baker is a native of the Seattle area and earned his Bachelor's degree from the University Of Washington School Of Music, where he studied with international concert pianist Robin McCabe. Joel moved to the desert in 2003 and has remained busy ever since. Currently, Joel can be found running an open mic at Roost Lounge on Monday nights; playing for The Judy Show at The Purple Room, and playing for open mic night at Play Lounge on Wednesdays.

A recipient of two Desert Theater League awards for his work in the local cabaret scene, Joel was honored to serve as Music Director for two world premieres in 2024: Industrial Strength Broadway, at the McCallum, and Straight To The Heart, at Dezart Productions. Joel is thrilled to be the principal

accompanist for PSGMC since 2013.

Chip is thrilled to be involved with PSGMC after a 22-year absence from Palm Springs. While living in New York City he sang in and accompanied the NYC Gay Men's Chorus, under Dr. Charles Beale. Chip has had over 30 years of experience playing piano and conducting Broadway shows and tours. He served as Associate Conductor on the National Tour of Newsies and can be heard playing piano in the Broadway HD movie. New York and National Tour keyboard and/or conducting credits include Les Misérables, Sunset Boulevard, Miss Saigon, Mary Poppins, Ragtime, The Fantasticks, and A Gentleman's Guide to Love and Murder. Back in the desert since 2020, Chip most recently music-directed and accompanied Coachella Valley Repertory's 2023 West Coast Premiere of The Fantasticks, a Love Story Reimagined. He is honored to direct Bruce Kenyon's The Arrangement.



Jeff Kopasz Music & Rehearsal Assistant

Tenor Section Leader, joined PSGMC in 2016. He is in his 13th year teaching Music in schools, the past 7 of which are here locally with Palm Springs Unified School District. He has also music-directed several full-scale and "Broadway Junior" musicals at his schools.

Jeff is an active member of the Palm Springs Teachers Association and serves as one of their CTA State Council reps. A graduate of Chapman University's Conservatory of Music (B.M. Music Education; Conducting), he is currently studying for a Masters degree at CSU San Bernardino.



Doug Nagel Resident Vocal Coach

Montana native Doug Nagel sang over 80 operatic baritone roles including Count, Scarpia, Magnifico, Dutchman, Wotan, Figaro, Jochanaan, and Germont. Doug recently returned to Billings to sing Jochanaan and direct Rimrock Opera Foundation's Salomé. Doug premiered the role of Theseus in Roumanis' Phædra, broadcast on PBS. International attention came when he created the role of de Santander in the Virginia Opera world premiere of Musgrave's Simon Bolívar, later singing the role at Royal Albert Hall, London, broadcast on the BBC. Mr. Nagel is heard on Albany Records in Nosferatu as the title role of Orlock (Dracula).

Nagel was the Artistic Director of Opera Idaho and Rimrock Opera, where he guided 30 productions including, Aïda, Così, Traviata, Butterfly, Crucible, Barber, Merry Widow, Bohème, Figaro, Girl of the Golden West, Elixir, Tosca, Carmen, Die Fledermaus, to name some. Doug has judged the Metropolitan Opera National Council Auditions and sat on the NEA Opera Grant Committee.

Nagel recently retired as Associate Professor from MSU Billings, residing in the Coachella Valley with his husband, Steve Baker, a longtime member of PSGMC and former board President. Nagel and Baker started Coachella Valley Classical Voices (CVCV), a new nonprofit, producing free concerts of Opera and Broadway throughout the valley. The Cathedral City Arts Council has just awarded CVCV a grant to produce Mr. Nagel's 50-minute bilingual version of Hansel and Gretel in Cathedral City.
