From 2005-2009, Jerry served as Artistic Director for the San Diego Men's Chorus, where he led the chorus through a number of milestones, including performing as main stage entertainment on an ocean liner for RSVP cruises, singing the national anthem for the San Diego Padres, and becoming the resident choral ensemble in the newly renovated Balboa Theatre in downtown San Diego. He also has held artistic and executive leadership positions with Berkeley Playhouse and Windy City Performs. He currently teaches in the Palm Springs Unified School District.
